Participants will participate in a detailed discussion of pertinent anatomy and technique for precisely placing both scope and instrument portals. Following discussion will be full day labs in arthroscopy and laparoscopy to ensure that participants are able to accurately and atraumatically place portals, correctly orient their field of view and identify landmarks and anatomic structures, and perform commonly performed procedures in arthroscopy and laparoscopy.

Procedures are all under the direct supervision of experienced board certified surgeons who have been leaders in the fields of arthroscopy and laparoscopy

Arthroscopy —

Selecting & assembling equipment

Recognizing anatomical landmarks required for orientation during arthroscopy.

Accurately placing instrument portals to ensure successful surgeries

Recognizing common pathologic conditions treated arthroscopically

Performing some of the common arthroscopic surgeries

Selecting and assembling equipment

Understanding equipment function and use (Insufflator, vessel sealing devices, etc.)

Review of anesthetic considerations for laparoscopy

Understanding normal anatomy

Performing common laparoscopic procedures

Indications for converting to an open procedure
